DESCRIPTION

RENO C761 BASE is the ideal plaster substrate for mineral substrates, as it creates an adhesion and solid connecting bridge between the substrate and the subsequent plaster.

AREAS OF APPLICATION

RENO C761 BASE is particularly suitable as an adhesive bridge for a subsequent coating with RENO C762 FINISH a in interior and exterior applications.

It adheres excellently to mineral substrates and in turn forms an absorbent substrate for subsequently applied plaster mortar (e.g. renovation plaster or cement mortar).

On smooth, non-absorbent and carbonized or weathered substrates, security can be further optimized by coating with adhesive emulsion concentrate.

Cleaning	Clean the tool and dirty areas immediately with water. When fully dried, Spraying only mechanically or with limescale remover remove.

APPLICATION

- Pour water into a clean bucket.
- Add **RENO C761 BASE** and mix by hand, in a mortar bucket with slow-running mixer or with commercially available continuous mixer (mixing time approx. 3 minutes) the mix should be a pre-spray consistency.
- Spray RENO C761 BASE is surface-rough, wart-shaped and not fully comprehensive (coverage approx. 50%).
- ⁻ The material must be processed before thickening begins.
- Material that has already been set must not stirred up or re mixed
- **RENO C761 BASE** should be protected against rapid dehydration, especially outside in sunlight and wind, inside from draughts and thermal stress as well as from frost protect.
- Spraying RENO C761 BASE is not specifically used as a levelling mortar

PREPARATION OF THE SUBSTRATE

The substrate must be mineral, load-bearing and free gypsum and any separating layers, e.g. bitumen, oils, dust, paints, etc.

Loose parts, if possible, remove dry, dispose of any construction waste daily.

Knock off old plaster up to approx. 80 cm above the moisture limit. Brittle masonry joints approx. 2-3 cm deep. Damaged stones must be replaced. Clean masonry thoroughly with compressed air or steel broom .

Good adhesion to the substrate must be ensured. In order to avoid salt returns, construction waste is disposed of in the proximity of the redevelopment object on a daily basis.

For salt-contaminated substrates, we recommend treatment with the **CLEAN R581 ANTI SULFAT** as an accompanying measure.

CURING

Subsequent plaster application with e.g., renovation plaster **RENO C762 FINISH** should be done after 24 to 48 hours, if possible, in order to exclude adhesion problems caused by sintering.

OCCUPATINAL HEALTH & SAFETY

Contains cement, reacts alkaline with water.
