## DESCRIPTION

Bostik 10-02 High Temperature Adhesive is a sodium silicate adhesive of buttery consistency suitable for use in high temperature applications. It can be used for bonding fibrous insulation materials, calcium silicate or magnesia insulation to galvanised ducting, unpainted steel, concrete and brickwork.

## APPLICATION

IMPORTANT: Before using Bostik 10-02 High Temperature Adhesive refer to the relevant Health & Safety Data Sheet, available at www.bostik.com/uk.

#### PREPARATION

- Surfaces must be clean, dry and free from dust, oil, grease and any loose materials.
- Stir the adhesive thoroughly before use.
- Bostik 10-02 High Temperature Adhesive dries to form a hard and brittle film and is therefore unsuitable for joints liable to movement. The dried film is not waterproof, so Bostik 10-02 High Temperature Adhesive is only suitable for use in dry locations.

## APPLICATION

- Apply evenly over the surface to be bonded using a brush or flat bladed tool, at a rate of 2.5m<sup>2</sup> per litre.
- Press insulation into place within 2 to 3 minutes. This type of adhesive does not have a strong initial tack and some support may be necessary for high density materials.

## CLEANING

• Clean tools and equipment with warm water immediately after use. Remove excess adhesive whilst it is still wet. Cured adhesive can be removed with water.

## STORAGE

• Store and transport securely in an upright position. Ensure the lid is secure. Store for up to 18 months from date of manufacture in original, unopened packaging in cool, dry conditions within the temperature range +5°C to +25°C and out of direct sunlight. Protect from frost.
