USES

Bostik Rapid Repair for Concrete Floors & Kerbs is a fast curing two-part epoxy repair compound that provides granite hard permanent repairs. It is many times stronger and more durable than concrete and is ideal for heavy traffic areas. It bonds to most building materials without the need for a primer.

Bostik Rapid Repair for Concrete Floors & Kerbs is suitable for: patch repairs to concrete floors, steps, kerbs, slabs, pipes etc., repairs to spalled concrete, repairs to cracks in masonry & concrete and leveling uneven industrial floors.

Storage/Shelf Life	Store and transport securely in an upright position. Ensure the lid is fully closed. Store for up to 12 months from date of manufacture in original, unopened packaging in cool, dry conditions within the temperature range +5°C to +25°C and out of direct sunlight. Protect from frost.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

IMPORTANT: Before using Bostik Rapid Repair for Concrete Floors & Kerbs, refer to the relevant Health & Safety Data Sheet, available at www.bostik.com/uk.

PREPARATION

- Ensure the surface is sound, clean and free from loose material, laitance, grease, oil, dirt dust and other surface contamination.
- 2. Feather edging is not recommended. Wherever possible saw cut around the perimeter edge.
- 3. Do not use at temperatures below 5°C.

- 4. Protective gloves are recommended.
- 5. Ensure there is enough time to complete the application. The full contents of the bucket have to be mixed together before use. This starts the curing process so all the product has to be used in one application.

MIXING

- Add the full contents of the liquid hardener component into the base resin.
- 7. Use the bucket as a mixing vessel.
- Use a mechanical mixer at slow speed to mix the two components to a lump-free consistency, usually about 5 minutes.
- 9. Pay particular attention to the sides and bottom of the bucket to ensure all contents are combined.

APPLICATION

- 10. This compound can be applied at thicknesses between 3mm to 25mm.
- 11. Some applications may require a temporary shutter.
- 12. Apply the compound with a trowel to the prepared area. Press the mortar well into the cavity and compact to ensure a good bond.
- 13. Smooth with a steel trowel.
- 14. Finishing may be aided as follows:
 - Thoroughly clean the trowel to remove any compound.
 - b. Wipe with cloth dampened with white spirit.
 Smooth once.
 - c. Repeat as necessary.

CLEANING

- 15. Clean tools and equipment with water immediately after use.
- 16. Do not allow Bostik Rapid Repair for Concrete Floors & Kerbs to cure because the epoxy resin coating cannot be dissolved with solvents and is difficult to remove mechanically.

PRECAUTIONS IN USE

Bostik Rapid Repair for Concrete Floors & Kerbs is not suitable for areas involving foodstuffs or anywhere there is a possibility of tainting.

Colour indicated on pack is a guide only. Shade variations may occur between different batches. When completing projects requiring multiple buckets, please ensure they are from the same batch.
