Bostik Repair & Pointing Mortar Kit can be used externally for patch repairs to external paving, repairs to paths, pointing of brickwork and masonry, repairs to concrete and stone steps and bedding and pointing of flagstones. It can also be used internally for filling holes around pipework. Simply mix in the bucket and apply with the trowel provided.

#### PREPARATION

Coverage

- 1. Ensure the surface is sound, clean and free from loose material, laitance, grease, oil, dirt, dust and other surface contamination.
- Where repairs are being carried out, feather edging is 2. not recommended; therefore, the perimeter of the areas to be repaired should be cut back to provide a 5mm minimum thickness for the repair material.
- Prior to application, surfaces should be roughened and З. thoroughly dampened with clean water, ensuring any pooled surface water is removed.

#### **MIX RATIOS**

- Mix 1.3 1.6 litres of water per 10kg bucket.
  1.3 litres will give a dry pack consistency.
  1.6 litres will give a good general-purpose mix.
- Mix 650ml 800ml of water per 5kg bucket.
  650ml will give a dry pack consistency.
  800ml will give a good general-purpose mix.

#### MIXING

- Bostik Repair & Pointing Mortar Kit can be mixed in the bucket by hand or by using a slow speed drill and mixing paddle.
- 7. Add 1.3 litres of water per 10kg bucket and mix thoroughly. Up to 300ml of extra water can be added if a more workable mix is required.
- Add 650ml of water per 5kg bucket and mix thoroughly. Up to 150ml of extra water can be added if a more workable mix is required.
- 9. The working life is approximately 1 hour after mixing.

#### **APPLICATION**

## Patch repairs:

10. Apply the material to the prepared substrate with the trowel provided to a maximum of 15mm thickness per layer. For deeper repairs, allow to cure for 2 to 3 days before adding further layers. Compact into place, and then finish off with a steel or wooden float.

#### Pointing brickwork:

- All loose mortar should be raked out to a depth of at least 10mm. Dampen the joints with water prior to pointing. Mix the mortar as described previously and apply using the trowel provided.
- 12. Protect mortar from inclement weather conditions and direct sunlight until cured.

#### CLEANING

13. Clean tools and equipment with warm soapy water immediately after use.

#### **PRECAUTIONS IN USE**

Colour indicated on pack is a guide only. It is recommended that users mix a small amount of cement and allow to dry to determine colour suitability before commencing work. Shade variations may occur between batches. When completing projects requiring multiple buckets, please ensure that they are from the same batch.
