DIRECTIONS FOR USE

PREPARATION

- Surfaces to be bonded must be clean, dry and free from dust and grease. Do not stick on newly painted walls, rusted surfaces, or rubber and leather facings.
- 2. Ensure a small spot check is undertaken for any painted walls, given variances in paint quality and coatings.

APPLICATION

- 3. Cut tape to desired length.
- Press on desired surface, avoiding areas of direct sunlight.
- 5. Attach objects, pressing with strength. Any objects stuck to tape should be kept dry and clean, or it will affect the adhesive of the tape.

REMOVAL

6. Pull from surface with care.
