Self Skinning Mastic Sealer

Description

Bostik 5615 is a synthetic rubber mastic compound, black in colour, which has been specifically formulated to remain permanently flexible in use. It is predominantly used in the automotive aftermarket area for secondary sealing of windscreens where a durable, skinning product is required.

Features

- Excellent UV light resistance in glazing applications.
- Tenacious adhesion to nearly all surfaces.
- Good service temperature range (-35°C to 65°C).
- Minimal swell effect on rubber
- Self skinning

Recommended Uses

- Sealing of rubber gasket type windscreens
- Spot weld sealing



Application Instructions

Surface Preparation

Surfaces must be clean, dry and free from oil, dust and other foreign materials

Application Instructions

- 1. Cut a nozzle to extrude the required bead size.
- 2. Cut the end from the nipple on the cartridge.
- 3. Screw on the prepared nozzle.
- 4. Use a standard 300ml cartridge gun to apply the sealer.
- 5. Apply the sealant to one side of the joint and bring the other surface into contact while the sealant is still wet.
- 6. Use mechanical fastening (screws, rivets etc.) to secure the joint.

Windscreen sealing

Apply the sealant into the channels on the rubber gasket before fitting to the glass and flange
