DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Contains Isocayanates. Read and understand the Safety Data Sheet before using this product.

SURFACE PREPARATION

Ensure all surfaces are clean and dry.

Rubber: Roughen the surface using a clean emery cloth. Solvent wipe is not recommended as this may affect adhesion due to penetration of the solvent into the rubber. Bocosol S may be used as a primer for vulcanized and thermoplastic rubbers.

Metal: Sand blast and immediately solvent wipe using Bostik No. 3 Solvent using the wipe on, wipe off technique. After wiping well, prime immediately with well mixed Bostik 17 Primer. Allow the primer coat to dry for minimum one hour, maximum 24 hours before applying adhesive.

Non porous substrates: Solvent wipe using Bostik No. 3 Solvent using the wipe on, wipe off technique. Abrade smooth surfaces to improve adhesion.

APPLICATION

 The mixing ratios are guidelines. It is recommended that testing be carried out to determine the quantity of Boscodur No. 10 required for your specific application.

- When determining the correct mixing ratio for your application, ensure to determine pot life and open time (tack time) as well. The pot life of the mixture can vary greatly dependent on the product and usage level. The open time of the contact adhesive may also change with the addition of Boscodur No. 10.
- Precautions must be taken to ensure that the Boscodur No. 10 and the mixed uncured adhesive are not contaminated with water or water vapour, as this can have detrimental effects on bond strength.
- Stir the contact adhesive until completely homogenous before decanting.
- Measure out the required quantity of contact adhesive into a clean container. Measure out the required quantity of Boscodur No. 10 and add to the contact adhesive. Mix well to ensure a homogeneous solution.
- Mix up no more adhesive than can be used within the time that trials have shown to be maximum pot life.
- Carry out bonding as for the contact adhesive.
- Discard any unused mixture at the end of the pot life even if still liquid.

LIMITATIONS

- Not suitable for polyethylene, polypropylene or Teflon.
- Do not use on expanded Polystyrene foam.

CLEANING

Bostik No. 2 Solvent or Mineral Turpentine. Use Bostik No. 3 Solvent or White Spirits immediately to remove adhesive from sensitive surfaces such as PVC. Use Bostik Handy Wipe towels to remove adhesive from skin.

STORAGE AND SHELF LIFE

Store in cool, dry conditions out of direct sunlight below 25°C and away from naked flame or sources of heat. Store according to Dangerous Goods regulations. Shelf life is 12 months if stored in cool, dry conditions in original, unopened containers.

DISPOSAL

Empty containers, once dry, may be disposed of via local landfill.

If spilt, beware of flammable vapours. Absorb product with clay, sand or earth. Collect in properly labelled metal containers. Dispose of according to local authority regulations. Do not dispose of down drains or into waterways. Fully dried material is not hazardous.
