# **DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

Read the Safety Data Sheet before commencing work. Work in a well ventilated area, out of direct sunlight. Avoid contact with skin – wear solvent resistance gloves.

Check compatibility with rubber and plastic components that may come into contact with Clean Brake. Mask delicate substrates if necessary.

# APPLICATION

# AEROSOL

- Ensure part to be cleaned has cooled to room temperature.
- Shake the can well before use.
- Place a suitable collection container under the part to be cleaned.

- Starting at the top and spray liberally, washing the residues down and off into the collection container.
- Allow excess to run off.
- Dry with a clean absorbent cloth using the wipe on, wipe off technique, or leave to air dry.
- Ensure all cloths, paper towels and other absorbent surfaces are properly dried or immersed in water to soak overnight before discarding.
- Badly soiled areas may require more than one application.

#### **20L DRUM**

- Ensure part to be cleaned has cooled to room temperature.
- Decant Clean Brake into a suitable, clean container.
- Small parts may be fully immersed into the container and cleaned using a paintbrush.
- Remove cleaned item and allow to drain.
- Larger parts may be placed on absorbent towels and cleaned using a paintbrush dipped into the brake cleaner.
- Allow excess to run off.
- Dry with a clean absorbent cloth using the wipe on, wipe off technique, or leave to air dry.
- Ensure all cloths, paper towels and other absorbent surfaces are properly dried or immersed in water to soak overnight before discarding.

# LIMITATIONS

- Avoid contact with decorative and automotive finishes. These may be damaged if in contact with Clean Brake.
- At very low temperatures cold cans will not spray with high pressure.

# STORAGE AND SHELF LIFE

Store between 5 and 25°C, ventilate if above 25°C. Do not store above 35°C. Do not leave in trunk of car, inside car or anywhere in full sunlight or high temperatures, due to the high risk of bursting the can. Do not expose to temperatures exceeding 50°C.

Shelf life is a minimum of 2 years if stored as directed.
