SHELF LIFE

Can be stored 730 days in a clean dry place, in its original package at an average temperature of 25°C or below. Storage temperature should not exceed 40°C

STORAGE & HANDLING

Wear safety gloves and goggles when handling molten adhesive to minimize the risk of burns.

CLEANUP PROCEDURE


Mineral oil or parrafin wax, not to exceed the flash point as stated on the SDS, followed by a thorough purge with the adhesive itself.

BASIC USES

Typically used in product assembly and automotive door watershield applications.
